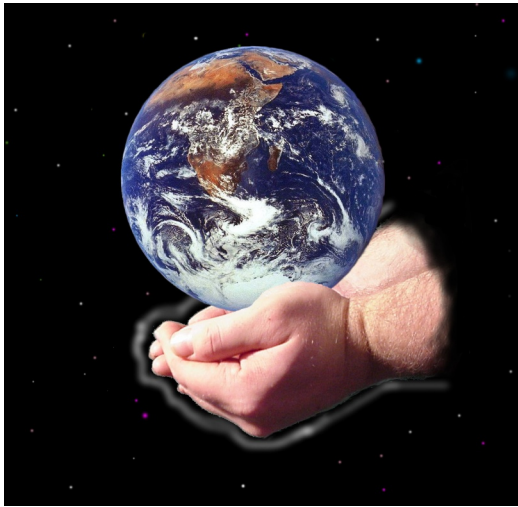


A Scientific perspective of the biblical record that will surprise and challenge you!

Charles Templeton, a contemporary of Billy Graham and a fellow evangelist, preached to packed-out stadiums of 30,000 people. Thousands came to know the saving grace of Christ through his ministry. Yet a few years later, Templeton became an outspoken atheist, ultimately writing the book "Farewell to God."

WHY?

The body of Christ in so-called "closed" countries has a higher growth rate than the west - which is the most evangelized part of the world.

Heaven forbid! ***It is because this culture has been indoctrinated with a myth known as evolution, and this myth has even crept in to the body of Christ.***

Charles Templeton had been convinced by "scientists" that the earth was old and that we evolved. Therefore, Templeton (correctly) concluded that if that were true, then Jesus Christ and the apostles were wrong about the age of the earth and creation. If they were wrong about creation, then they were wrong about sin, heaven, and hell, and Jesus Christ was merely a misled man.

The body of Christ is responsible for the instruction of our youth. Our false beliefs, ignorance and apathy affect our youth. We need instruction on the falsehoods of evolution, and the veracity of the scriptures.

The Bible does *not* say 'Be ye transformed by the *removal* of your mind.' God gave us a brain to use, and commanded Adam to "subdue the earth." Our first mandate was to understand the creation!
